Bob Reynolds

Bob Reynolds is a saxophonist, composer, educator, and 3-time Grammy-winning member of the instrumental group Snarky Puppy. He has released 11 solo albums, several of which made Billboard's Top 10 Jazz charts. Widely recognized for his work with Snarky, and John Mayer, he's been a featured soloist with Grammy-winning instrumentalists Larry Carlton, Chris Botti, and Jeff Lorber. He's worked with a wide array of pop artists including Michael Bublé, The 1975, Idina Menzel, Josh Groban, USHER, and others. His solo albums showcase his melodic improvisational style, tuneful songwriting, and, as the LA Times put it, "hip-swiveling" grooves. Bob's live concert album, *Guitar Band*, has over 4 million views on YouTube. A pioneer in online education, Bob launched his innovative Virtual Studio in 2010, where he has since coached thousands of musicians. More than 90,000 people subscribe to Bob's YouTube channel, where he shares insights on developing good practice habits and overcoming doubt as a musician and artist.

Born in Morristown, New Jersey in 1977, Reynolds grew up in Jacksonville, Florida, where he started playing saxophone at age 13. Although he listened to a range of music as a kid, by his late teens he was a dedicated jazz student. After high school he honed his skills at Boston's Berklee College of Music, where he mentored with George Garzone, Hal Crook, and others. Bob is a passionate educator and in-demand clinician. He co-founded an annual retreat for saxophonists and, through his Virtual Studio, he helps musicians become confident improvisers. Bob lives in Los Angeles and shares insights on balancing a music career with raising a family through his popular YouTube vlog.
